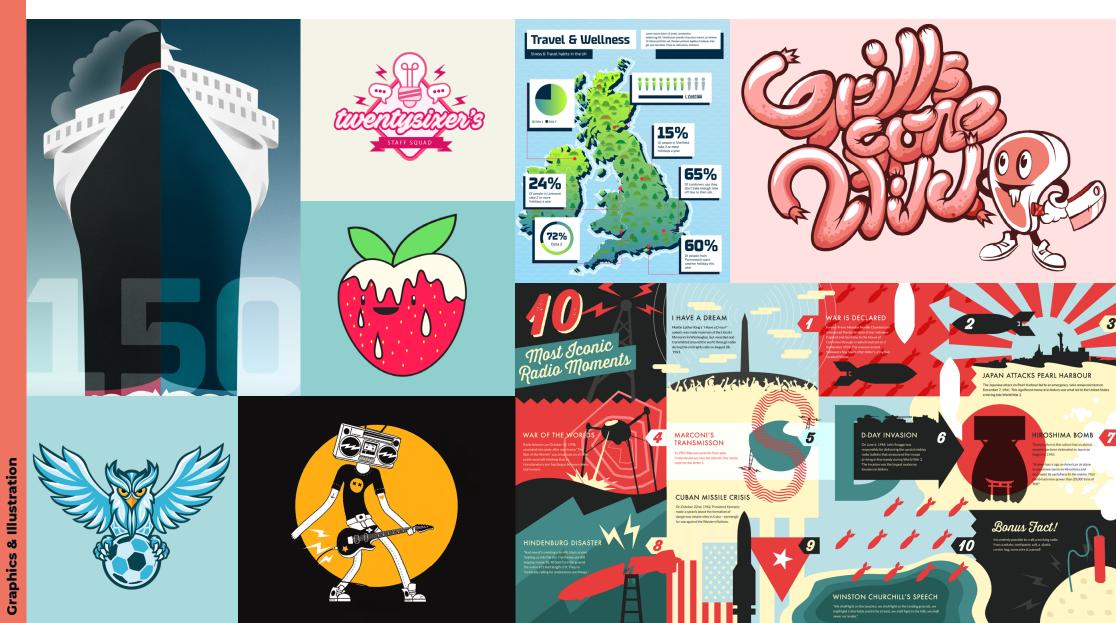
Photoshop & renders

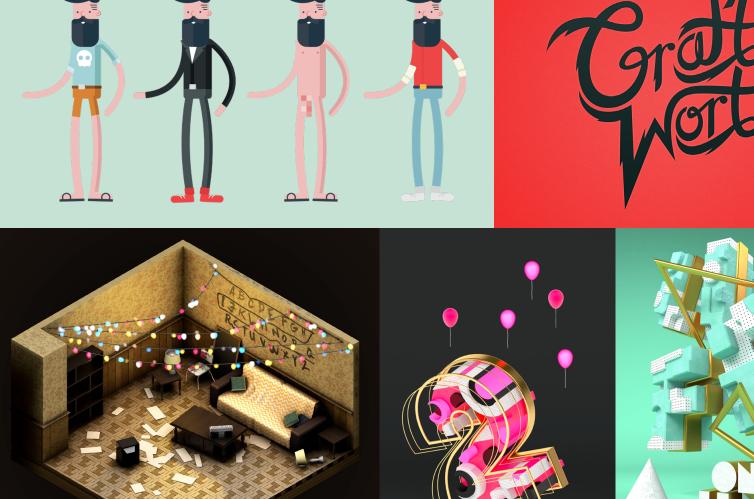

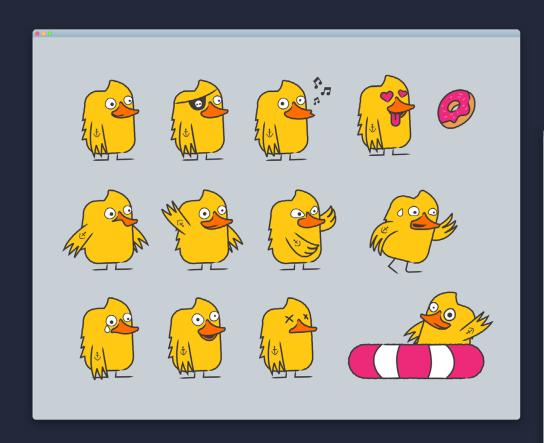


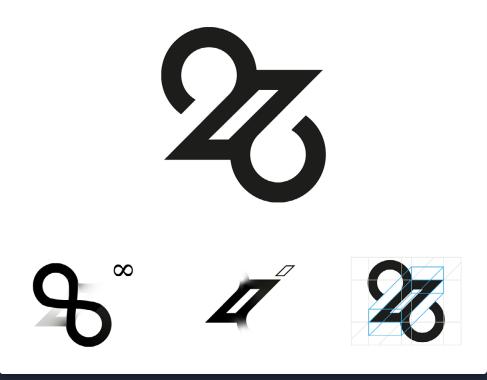

Figure 2 is the logo design for my previous agency 26. They wanted to move from a word mark to a more symbolic representation of the company. I incorporated the infinity symbol, a forward slash and dynamic lines to represent the company values, its also an ambigram.

A design concept for a 6 degrees of separation game called the Baconator, the concept being that you match up movies and actors that have starred with Kevin Bacon.







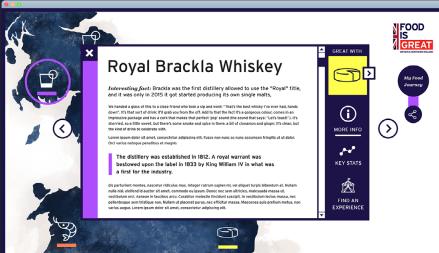


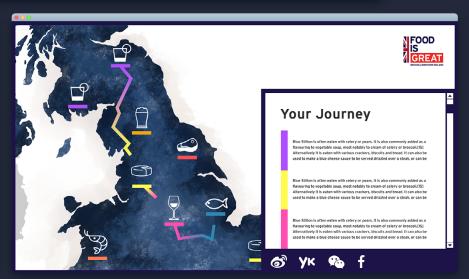
Defra interactive map

An interactive map designed for Defra to introduce people to the various speciality foods available in the uk, to advertise the foods globally.





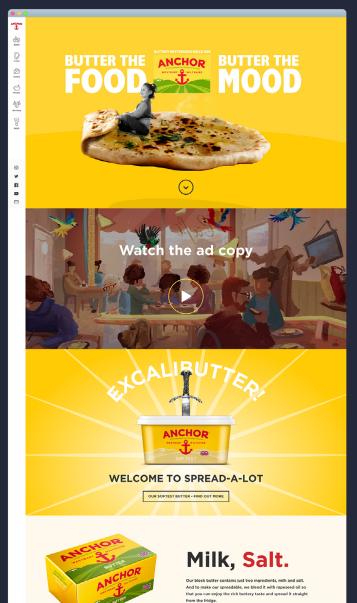






Arla foods

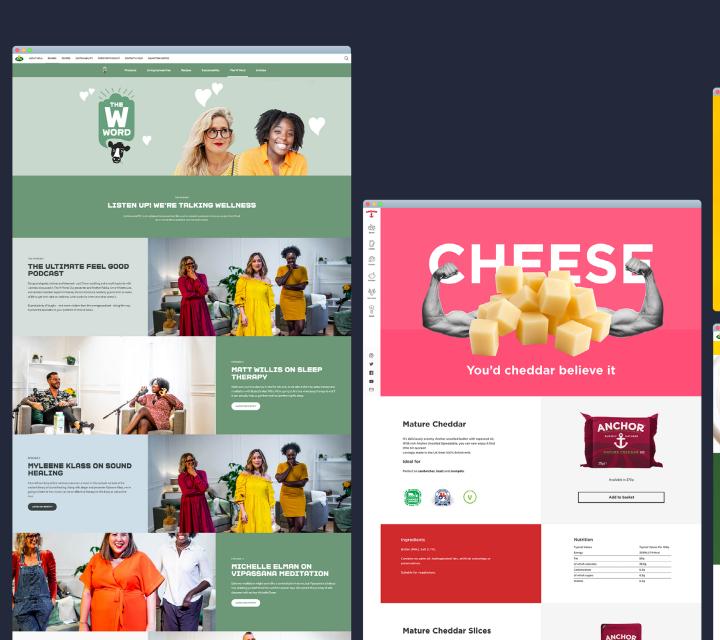


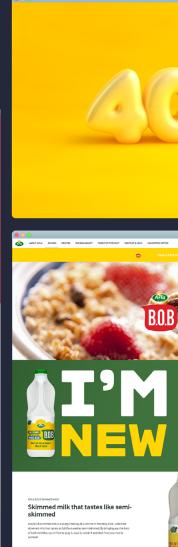


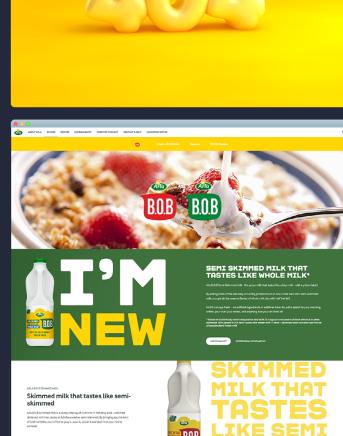

This included learning Optimizley their CMS which I would administer on an almost daily basis as well as building page concepts straight into the CMS.



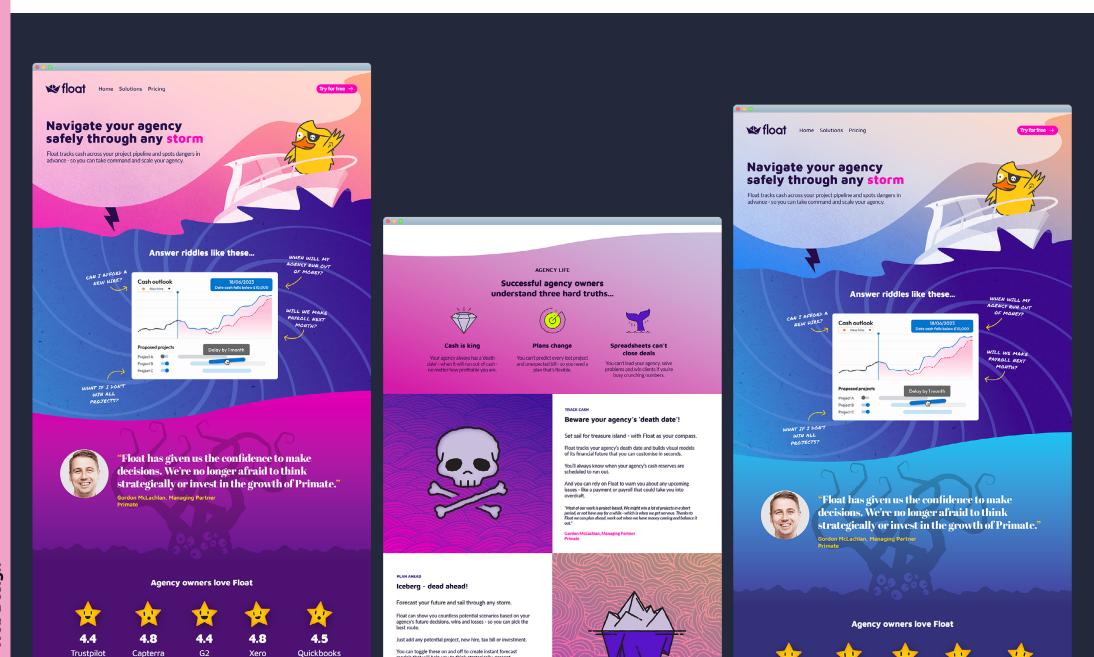

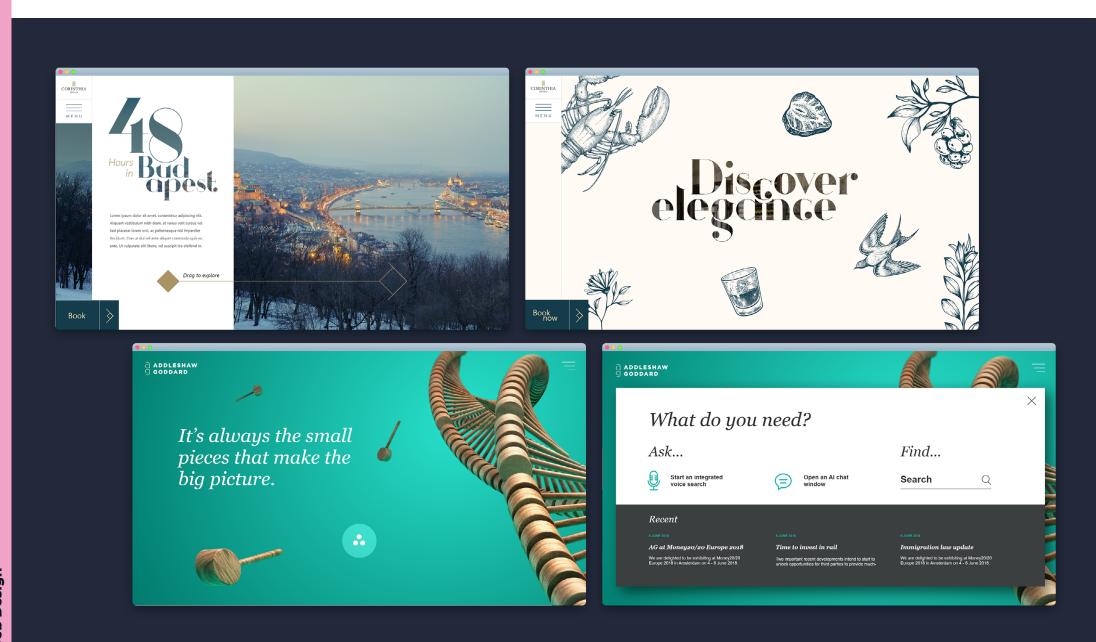
Float design concept

Pitch concepts

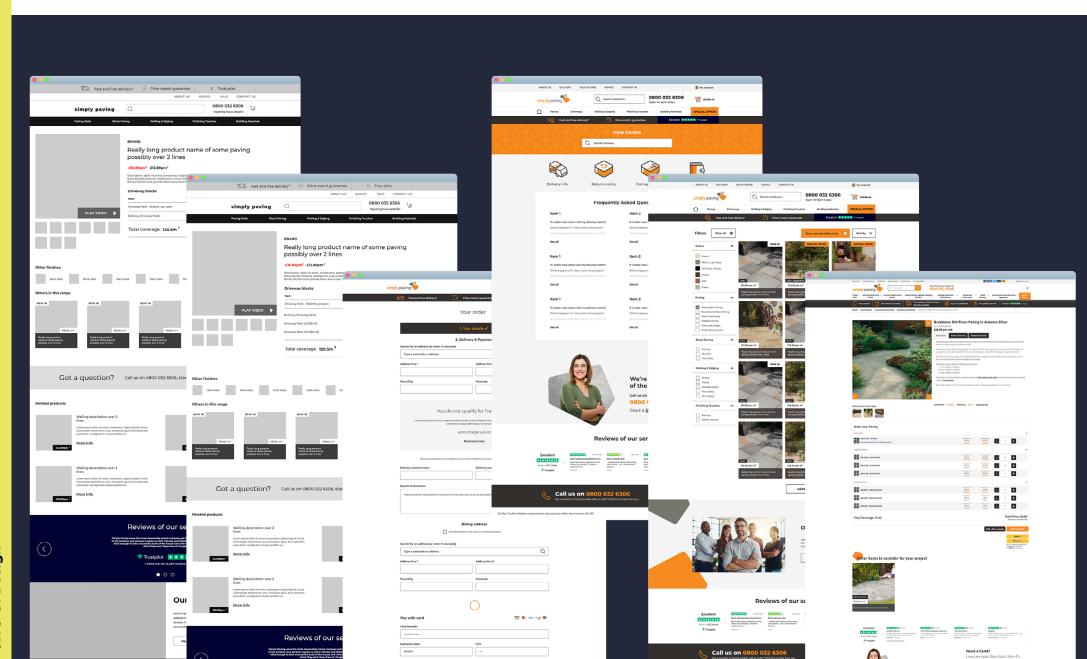
I regularly provided resource for pitches including coming up with unique ideas for what otherwise would be very basic (in terms of functionality) websites.

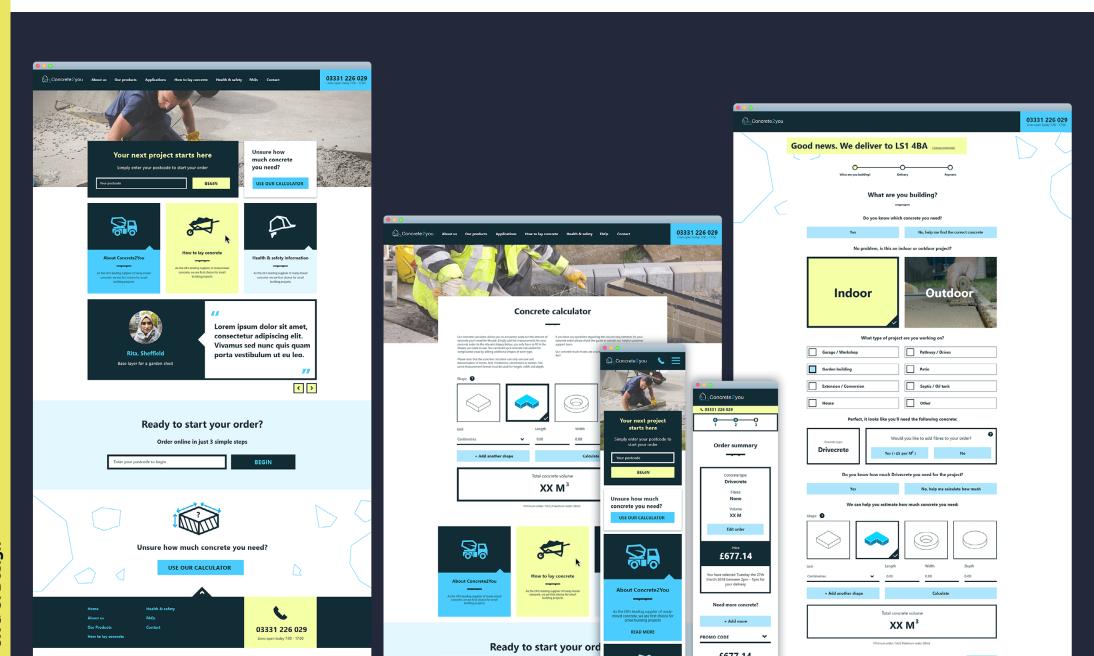
